Deep Dewatering Wells	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>11 operational deep dewatering wells (DDW)</li> <li>Current extraction rate is 1.1- 1.15 million gal/day with a total of about 145 million gallons (445 acre ft) of water extracted to date.</li> <li>The City continues to monitor the DDWs.</li> </ul>
Winterization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Planned Winterization Work has been completed</li> <li>Continuing to monitor Winterized areas</li> </ul>
GPS Surveying	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>City Geologists are reviewing the survey and will publish the information as soon as its available.</li> </ul>

Gas Pipeline Inspections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SoCal Gas is conducting geological studies in conjunction with the City to determine the feasibility of service restoration.</li> <li>SoCal Gas has installed more than 26 additional survey read points across RPV and RHE</li> </ul>
Pipe Response Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The data collected is being used to design a computer algorithm that monitors stress and strain on below ground utilities based on current and potential land movement</li> <li>In the final stages of design and is critical to implementing restoration plans</li> <li>Expect to have the final design of the model and implementation plans for each community in the second quarter of 2025, if conditions allow.</li> <li>Will be referencing SCE's style of community engagement when the time comes</li> </ul>
Resident Shutoff Data	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>138 residents were shut off from the system in the Portuguese Bend Community and will continue to be shut off indefinitely</li> <li>30 customers in Beach Club were shut off, SoCal Gas has installed 1 isolation valve for the community</li> <li>38 customers in the Seaview Neighborhood were shut off, SoCal Gas has installed 12 isolation valves for the community, 3 residents in Seaview were offered alternative forms of service (Natural Gas Cylinders) which were declined</li> </ul>
Rotary Club Funds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>\$164,000 available for residents that were impacted by the shutoff</li> <li>Funds not available to residents who received the initial \$2,500 from SoCal Gas</li> <li>30 Applications have been received, application deadline has been extended</li> <li>No money will be distributed until all the applications have been received and processed</li> </ul>
Q&A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Q: Can residents still be considered for the funds even if they received the initial \$2,500?</li> <li>A: No, members of the Portuguese Bend Community have already received a form of financial assistance</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Q: Will members of Seaview and Beachclub be receiving more than \$2,500?</li> <li>A: The method and amount of funds being distributed has not been determined yet; this is up to the Rotary Clubs discretion.</li> <li>Q: Why were original \$2,500 sent out to the Portuguese Bend Community taxed.</li> <li>A: Any amount of \$600 or more is considered taxable income. Will get more information on this topic.</li> <li>Q: Is worst case scenario, residents won't be getting service until after June of this year?</li> <li>A: Correct</li> <li>Q: Why does it take so long to restore service to residents who are already compliant when SCE was able to do it sooner?</li> <li>A: The comparison is not valid because the SoCal Gas lines are below ground, so the processes for restoration are very different.</li> <li>Q: Where are the applications available for the Rotary Club funds?</li> <li>A: Applications will be redistributed.</li> </ul>
