<p><u>City Update</u> (this could include updates on emergency declaration(s), geological and/or geotechnical, mitigation projects, project funding, and other topics)</p> <p>Deep Dewatering Wells (DDW)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Several wells appear to have pinching and are being assessed for redrilling or other methods to address it • All DDWs will continue to be monitored for pinching/shearing and re-drilling plans will be developed as needed • Transitioning from a developmental phase of DDWs to a more maintenance and operation focused approach, potential for different contractors to get involved <p>Winterization Measures</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Winterization measures are substantially complete • Continuing to monitor and perform maintenance in advance of wet weather events <p>Landslide Monitoring Points Survey</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The most recent partial survey was sent to utilities and will be posted on City's website soon • A full survey is starting and should be complete by the end of next week • City has posted the most recent survey on the City's website <p><u>Utility Updates</u></p> <p>Frontier Communications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No updates, continuing to work on service issues • Still planning on bringing fiber optics to the Portuguese Bend Area, no schedule as of recently • Q: <p>Cal Water:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No significant updates, continuing work for phase 2 of Burma Road • Q: What's the update on the replacement of the existing underground utilities from Schooner West? • CalWater A: There are no other projects planned besides the Burma road project, but residents will be notified of any future plans. More information to come. • Q: What was the update on the two water line breaks along Dauntless drive? • CalWater A: The underground waterlines were repaired, service was restored, and clean up is complete. <p>DISCUSSION ITEMS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Q: What can residents expect moving forward with the reenergization of the Beach Club and Seaview, specifically for those who have not been reenergized? A: The city will relay the message to SCE. <p>SoCal Gas</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Latest updates can be found online at SoCalGas.com/pvlandmovement Issued a comprehensive statement updating all the cities along the peninsula After the 7 qualified residents who were offered natural gas cylinders declined, SoCal Gas is no longer offering that option Long term planning underway for qualified residents for restoration of service Pipe response model is being developed which determines the stress and strain of underground gas lines based on the current and potential land movement in order to devise a restoration plan The restoration plan is forecasted to be complete in the second quarter of 2025 Q: There was no mention of removing meters in Beach Club area in the letter posted on the SoCal Gas website, why were some meters removed? A: There will be a follow up, part of restoring service will be to return meters. <p>LACSD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The construction south of Klondike Canyon, by the Seaview neighborhood, is complete Currently working on the portion in between Klondike Canyon and the pumping plant off Seacove. Night work is planned for the coming weeks Q: Was the access area off PVDS constructed by LACSD? A: LACSD did not construct it, unsure of who the owner is. City will follow up. <p>LACPW</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continuing to monitor the Sewers in Seaview Neighborhood with no indication of issues or rainwater infiltration <p>PBCA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No Updates <p>Abalone Cove Landslide Abatement District (ACLAD)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Well drilling in progress No further updates <p>Klondike Canyon Landslide Abatement District (KCLAD)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Both wells are operational 24/7 with power reconnected. Depth to water is about 90 feet. Producing a combined water exfiltration rate of 245 GPM. Possibly adding another well in the Spring <p>Seaview HOA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No updates <p>Beach Club HOA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No updates
