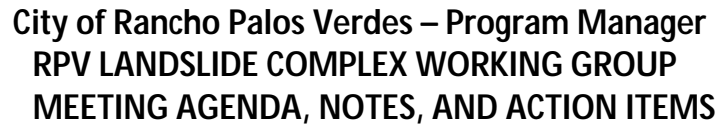

Deep Dewatering Wells	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 9 Deep Dewatering Wells (DDWs) are extracting groundwater at a rate of 680 gallons per minute, or approximately 1 million gallons per day. Approximately 192 million gallons, or 589 acre-ft have been extracted to date. DDW-10 has pinched off and will be evaluated for a re-drill if budget becomes available.
Winterization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Planned Winterization Work has been completed Continuing to monitor forecast for rain outside of the rainy season
GPS Surveying	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Full survey was completed last week Results will be shared with the group as soon as the city receives them

A traffic control plan is currently being developed and sent to the City tomorrow The City will take photos of areas where there are net export of dirt to give a general idea of how much fill material is available for Portuguese Bend. It will be stockpiled nearby. Dave Copp, Ted Brodeur (LACSD) will be visiting the site and will share additional information with Gordon (ACLAD) shortly thereafter.

A from SCE: One of the properties indicated that they do not want to be reenergized, the other two are a few weeks out from finding a solution. Q from Seaview HOA: Are there any updates regarding the box loop and how discussions with the City are going? A from SCE: Unsure on the progress on this, SCE will bring this up to the team and follow up. A from RPV: The City is tentatively planning to present the box loop options to the City Council on May 20. The agenda will be published a week prior.
