NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 18, 2008, at 7:00 p.m. at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, to consider the following project:

**Appeal of the Planning Commission approval of Case No. ZON2007-00492 (Conditional Use Permit – Revision “D”, Grading Permit, Minor Exception Permit, Sign Permit and Environmental Assessment):** An appeal of the Planning Commission’s approval of a Master Plan for the St. John Fisher Property to allow the construction of a new sanctuary, preschool, administration building, library, art room, storage area, garage and offices; demolition of existing rectory, youth building and offices; remodel existing offices and classrooms, converting the existing convent into a new rectory and converting the existing sanctuary into a new gymnasium, 30,688 cubic yards of grading (excavation, fill and export), and a new sign at the corner of Crest Road and Crenshaw Boulevard. 
