## **NOTICE**

On April 28, 2015, the Planning Commission reviewed the Western Avenue Vision Plan Design Guidelines, which included three (3) options (Options A, B and C) for street design. In light of the comments received by the public and the Planning Commission at that meeting, the City's Consultant (AECOM) created a fourth option (Option D). The original document with Options A, B and C, and an updated Powerpoint presentation illustrating Option D will be presented for further public input at the following public meetings:

- On Monday, June 22, 2015, the Traffic Safety Commission will meet in the City Hall Community Room at 7:00 PM, located at 30940 Hawthorne Blvd., Rancho Palos Verdes.
- On Tuesday, June 23, 2015, the Planning Commission will meet at Hesse Park Community Building at 7:00 PM, located at 29301 Hawthorne Blvd., Rancho Palos Verdes.
- On Tuesday, July 7, 2015, the City Council will meet at Hesse Park Community Room at 7:00 PM, located at 29301 Hawthorne Blvd., Rancho Palos Verdes.

These DRAFT Guidelines and alternative street design options have been prepared for the Cities of Rancho Palos Verdes and Los Angeles to develop a consistent and cohesive implementation tool for Western Avenue, with a goal to create an environment that invites better mobility for various users and creates a more inviting commercial destination.
