

Western Avenue Corridor Design Implementation Guidelines

On April 28, 2015, the Planning Commission reviewed the Western Avenue Corridor Design Implementation Guidelines (“Guidelines”), which included three (3) options (Options A, B and C) for street design. The DRAFT Guidelines and alternative street design options have been prepared for the Cities of Rancho Palos Verdes and Los Angeles to develop a consistent and cohesive implementation tool for Western Avenue, with a goal to create an environment that invites better mobility for various users and creates a more inviting commercial destination.

A consensus of the Planning Commission on April 28, 2015 did not support any of the three options and instead recommended that the City Council pursue a fourth Option D. Since that time, the Draft Guidelines have been presented to the City of RPV Traffic Safety Committee, the San Pedro Neighborhood Council Boards, and the City of LA’s Harbor Area Planning Commission. The City’s Traffic Safety Committee’s recommendation as well as the City of LA’s position on the Draft Guidelines will now be presented to the City of RPV Planning Commission to allow the Planning Commission an opportunity to augment or change its recommendation to the City Council before the Guidelines are presented to the RPV City Council in September.

The Guidelines, and associated materials, will be presented to the Planning Commission at its Tuesday, August 11, 2015 Planning Commission meeting, which will be held at Hesse Park Community Building at 7:00 PM, located at 29301 Hawthorne Blvd., in Rancho Palos Verdes. Any interested persons are encouraged to attend and/or submit comments to the Planning Commission.
