NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, May 10, 2016, at 7:00 PM at the Hesse Park Community Building, located at 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes to consider the following:

HEIGHT VARIATION (CASE NO. ZON2016-00078): A request to construct a 231 square foot addition at the rear of an existing two-story residence. The height of the addition will be 24'-2", as measured from highest elevation of the existing grade covered by the structure (elev. 99.10') to the highest proposed roof ridgeline (elev. 123.27'); and an overall height of 24'-8" as measured from lowest finished grade adjacent to the structure (elev. 98.60') to the highest proposed roof ridgeline (elev. 123.27').

LOCATION: 3608 Coolheights Drive

PROPERTY OWNER: John & Pamela Peterson

APPLICANT: Boettcher Engineering & Contracting

The Height Variation procedure is for the construction of additions to existing residential structures that are proposed to be taller than sixteen (16') feet in height, but not to exceed a maximum height of twenty-six (26') feet. In reviewing a Height Variation application, the City will assess the impacts of the structure above 16 feet in height on the views from neighboring properties and from public areas, its cumulative impact on the effected properties, and compatibility of the proposed structure with existing surrounding uses. When reviewing a project's "Neighborhood Compatibility," the City will review the proposed project relative to the following criteria for the immediate neighborhood: 1) scale of surrounding residences; 2) architectural style and materials; and 3) front, side, and rear yard setbacks.

The reason you are receiving this notice is because your property is located within 500' of the proposed project. A temporary frame structure (silhouette) has been constructed on the project site outlining the height and bulk of the proposed project. This frame will be in place throughout the duration of the public comment period to better assist you and the City in assessing any potential project impacts.

If you have any comments or concerns about the proposed project, please communicate those thoughts in writing to Octavio Silva, Associate Planner by Friday, May 2, 2016. By doing so, you will ensure that your comments are taken into consideration for the Staff analysis of the project. All correspondence received after May 6, 2016, will be given separately to the Planning Commission on the night of the meeting. Please note that written materials, including emails, submitted to the City are public records and may be posted on the City's website. In addition,

Only those who have submitted written comments will receive notification of the decision.
