- Prior Rabies Certificate is required to receive a 3-year Rabies vaccine; otherwise the vaccine will be good for 1 year (License Renewal Notice containing Rabies expiration date may be accepted)
- Bring other vaccine records if possible
- If you have a CAT, proceed immediately to Cashier's table
- \$2 hazardous materials disposal fee will be charged per pet
- Prices below include a \$3 cash discount price per pet
- CASH or CREDIT/DEBIT CARD ONLY for all veterinary services

NOTIFY OUR STAFF UPON YOUR ARRIVAL IF YOUR PET HAS EVER HAD A REACTION TO A VACCINE, HAS RECENTLY SHOWN ANY SIGN OF ILLNESS, IS ON MEDICATION OR UNDERGOING TREATMENT FOR ANY MEDICAL CONDITION, IF IT IS NURSING PUPPIES/KITTENS, OR IF IT MIGHT BE PREGNANT.

RABIES (Thimerosal Free for Dogs & Cats) (Minimum Age: 3 mos) \$7

Optional for Cats: (Non-Adjuvant) Purevax 1-year Rabies \$20 Purevax 3-year Rabies \$48

DHP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvo) - or - **DHPP** (DHP with Parainfluenza) (Minimum Age: 6 wks) \$19

BORDETELLA w/PARAINFLUENZA (Intranasal Bronchiseptica & Parainfluenza) (Minimum Age: 6 wks) \$14

LYME (*Borrelia Burgdorferi*) (Minimum Age: 9 wks) \$22

FVRCP (Non-Adjuvant) (*Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calici, and Panleukopenia*) (Minimum Age: 6 wks) \$18

FELV (Non-Adjuvant) (*Feline Leukemia*) (Minimum Age: 8 weeks & older) \$21

♥ Ideally, pets should receive one of their sets of initial vaccines between the age of 14-16 weeks to achieve the best immunity against disease. During your pet's initial vaccine series, do not wait longer than 6 weeks apart to have your pet vaccinated. All pets adopted from shelters should receive vaccine boosters 1 month after adoption. ♥
